

# Cottonwood Street and Locarno Drive Highway Safety Improvements Project Public Meeting Information



In association with the Municipality of Anchorage Traffic Department, DOWL Engineers invites you to attend a public meeting concerning two projects within the Roger's Park and Tudor Area Community Council boundaries.

The first project is the Cottonwood Street and Locarno Drive Highway Safety Improvements Project. The following issues have been identified on 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Cottonwood Street and Locarno Drive.

- Elevated rate of rear-end collisions for westbound traffic,
- Turning movements at Locarno Drive and Cottonwood Street have few gaps in traffic during periods of heavy congestion,
- Sight distance at Locarno Drive and Cottonwood Street is hindered when traffic backs up over the crest of the hill east of these streets on 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

Two options have been identified as possible solutions to the issues stated above (see reverse side for options).

## Traffic Study

The second project is a traffic study of the Green Acres neighborhood. This study will address issues such as traffic congestion, speed concerns, cut-through traffic, arterial access and neighborhood traffic circulation. The study will evaluate the potential neighborhood traffic impacts from the HSIP project at 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Locarno Street.
